



Webbing Clothes Moth Treatment Notice

A Colorado Pest Management technician will be entering your home to treat for **webbing clothes moths**.

Proper preparation is required to ensure the treatment is effective. Please follow all steps below carefully.

Preparation Checklist

1. **Move all furniture and items 12–18 inches away from walls.**
2. **Remove as many items as possible from the floors and vacuum all rooms thoroughly.**
3. **Empty all closets completely.**
4. **Remove all bed linens** from every bed and **wash in hot water.**
5. **Empty all dressers and end tables** in the bedrooms.
6. **Wash all clothing and bedding** from closets, floors, beds, dressers, and end tables in **hot water.**
7. **Place clean clothing and bedding in sealed plastic bags** and tie them securely.
8. **Store the sealed bags in the bathroom or bathtub.** If space is limited, place bags in the center of the living room.
9. **Do not place anything** on beds, couches, chairs, tables, or dressers.
10. **Cover all electronics** (TVs, stereos, computers) with plastic.
11. **Cover fish tanks and turn off filters.**
12. **Remove all other pets** from the home for **2 hours.**
13. **Leave a note** for the technician identifying **where you've seen insects.**
14. **Be ready to leave your home when the technician arrives.**
You must **vacate the unit for 2 hours.**
15. **Ventilate your home before reentering.** Open windows if possible.
16. **Remake beds with clean linens** after treatment.
17. **Bag and take all wool and dry-clean-only clothing to the dry cleaner.**
18. **Place food, dishes, and utensils** inside cupboards, drawers, or the refrigerator.
If this is not possible, **cover them securely with plastic.**
